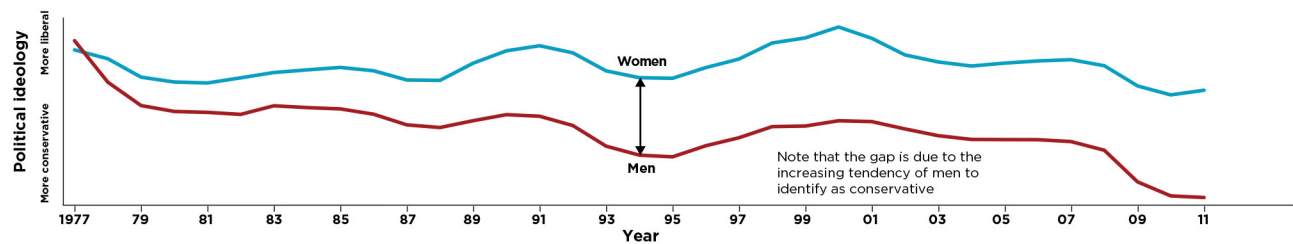
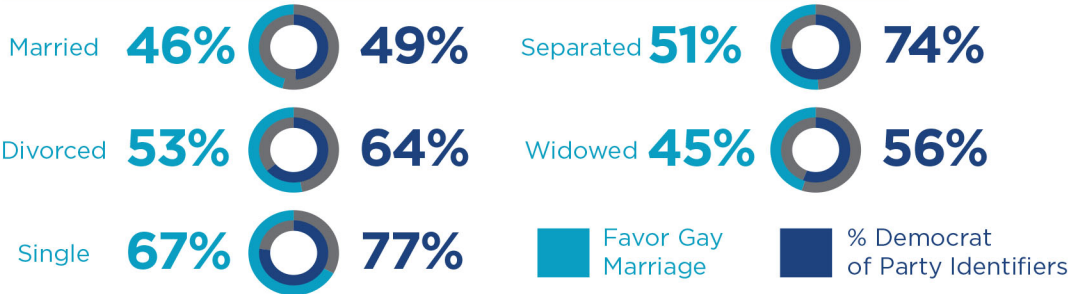


SNAPSHOT OF AMERICA: WHAT DO WE THINK, BY GENDER (AND MARRIAGE)?
