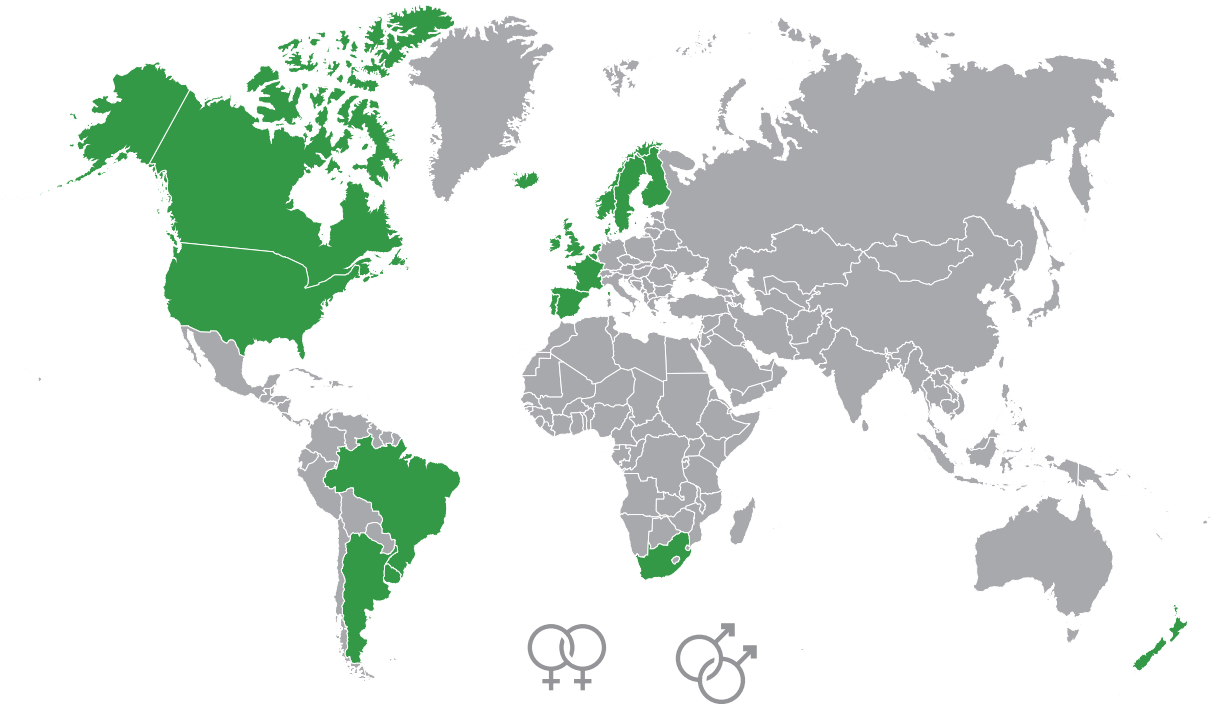























FIGURE 10.7 Countries Where Same-Sex Marriage Is Legal
