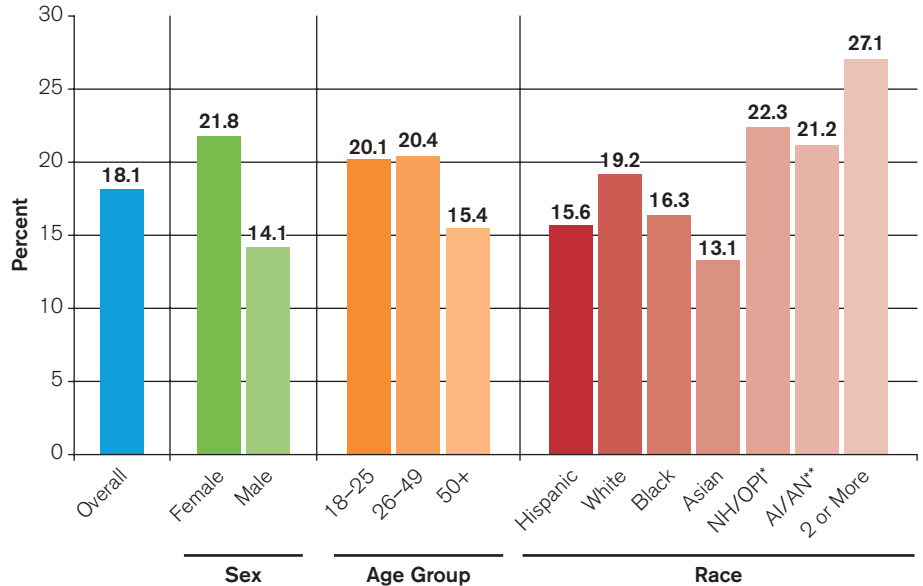


■ **FIGURE 1.1** Prevalence of Any Mental Illness Among U.S. Adults (2014)
