

FIGURE 9.1 How Do Individuals With Depersonalization Disorder Respond to Emotional Stimuli?

Individuals with depersonalization disorder showed reduced autonomic responses to unpleasant stimuli. This suggests that individuals with depersonalization disorder show inhibitory responses to negative emotional information. The control group and those with anxiety show larger responses to these stimuli. Responses are standardized as range-corrected scores (for each participant, skin conductance response magnitudes were computed as a proportion of that participant's largest response).
