

HOW TEXAS GOVERNMENT WORKS

Redistricting Process in Texas

Texas Legislature

Redistricting Texas's seats
in the U.S. House of
Representatives

Redistricting itself and other agencies like
the Texas State Board of Education

U.S. Court approves the plan or
rejects it and sends it back to
the legislature to fix

State or federal court invalidates
the Texas Legislature's plan
and sends it back to the
legislature to fix

OR

Texas Legislature
cannot agree to a
redistricting plan

Legislative Redistricting
Board (LRB), comprised of the
lieutenant governor, Speaker
of the Texas House, attorney
general, comptroller of
accounts, and commissioner
of the General Land Office,
takes on redistricting

LRB draws up a
redistricting plan

LRB submits its plan to the
Texas Legislature for approval

The final plan by the
legislature is enacted or used in
the next election after approval
by state or federal court
