Lawmaking

Idea for bill from:

- A person
- A state legislator
- An interim committee
- An organized interest

Legislation Introduced

Legislation may be introduced as early as 60 days prior to session.

First Reading
Referral to committee

Committee Work

Bills can originate in either the House or the Senate

First Reading
Referral to committee

An approved House bill with amendments is printed and sent to the Senate for consideration.

House Bill on Senate Floor

House Bill Sent to The Senate

Tagging

Public Hearings

Debate and Amendment

Committee Report

Placed on Senate Calendar

Second Reading

A majority vote of committee membership is required.

A senator may filibuster and hold the floor for an unlimited debate.

Senate amendments to House bills go to the House for approval

House concurs with amendments

Reconciled in conference committee

Debate and Amendment

Third Reading

Vote

Enrollment

A tie vote or failure to gain a simple majority
