Notes: *IDP* refers to internally displaced persons—those people who must leave their homes but are still in the country. *Group grievance* refers to those groups who feel they have suffered as victims of ethnic persecution or from political exclusion and whose concerns have not been addressed. *Human flight* refers to those people who choose to leave voluntarily.¹⁹
