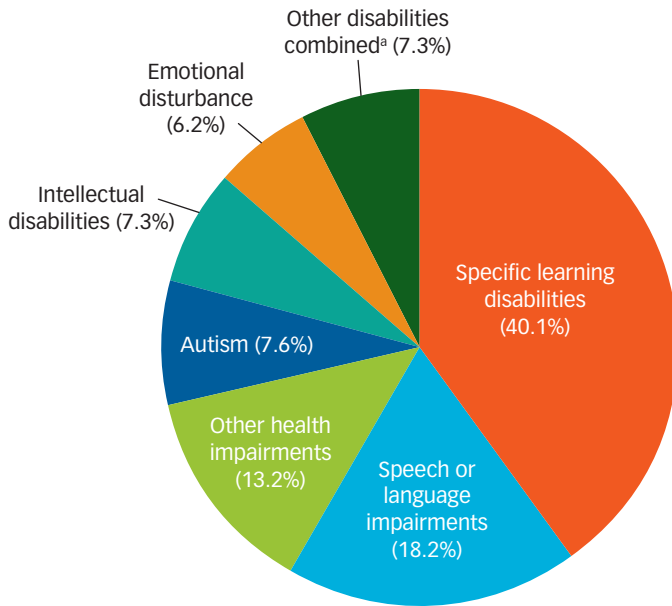


**FIGURE 22.1 An Overview of Disabilities and Disorders.** This graph shows the percentage of elementary through high school students with various disabilities and disorders receiving special education and related services under IDEA.



<sup>a</sup>“Other disabilities combined” includes *deaf-blindness* (less than 0.03 percent), *developmental delay* (2.1 percent), *hearing impairments* (1.2 percent), *multiple disabilities* (2.2 percent), *orthopedic impairments* (0.9 percent), *traumatic brain injury* (0.4 percent), and *visual impairments* (0.4 percent).

NOTE: Percentage was calculated by dividing the number of students ages 6 through 21 served under *IDEA*, Part B, in the disability category by the total number of students ages 6 through 21 served under *IDEA*, PART B, then multiplying the result by 100.
