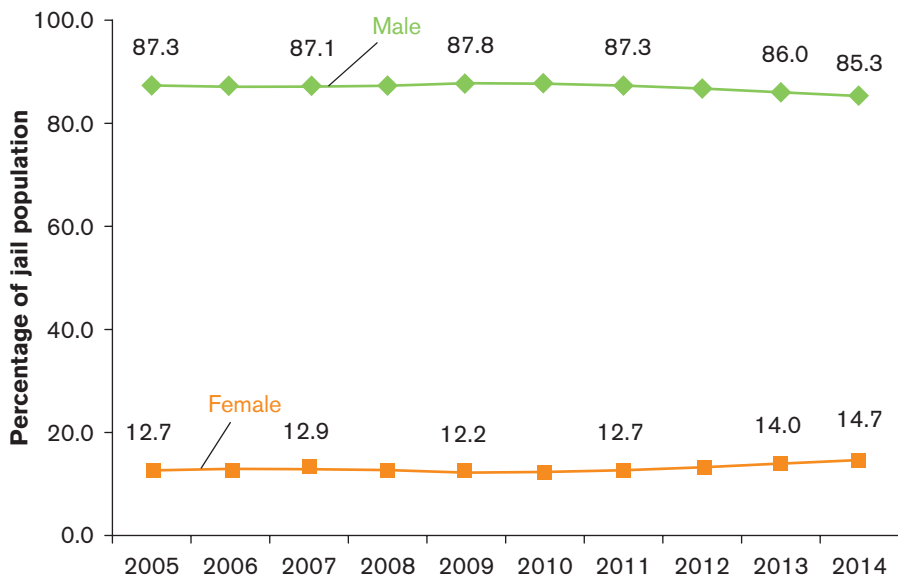


Figure 11.2 ■ Percentage of Jail Population by Gender, 2005–2014
