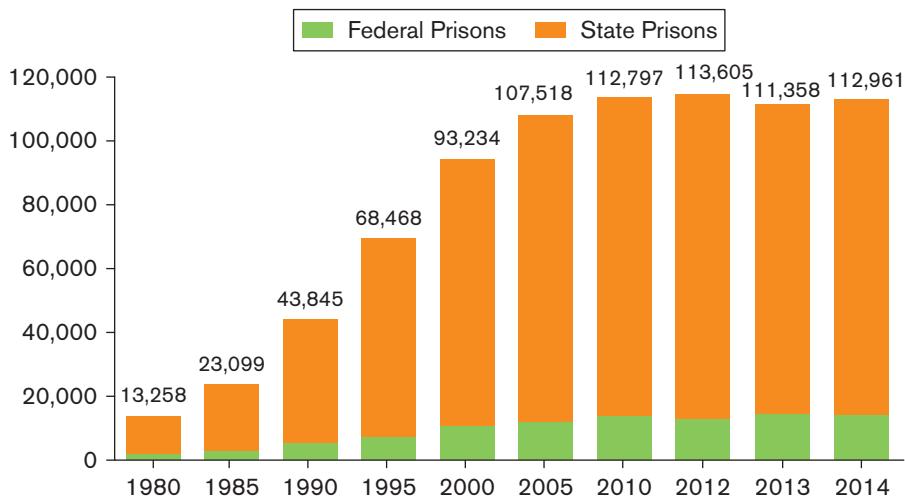


Figure 11.6 ■ Number of Women in State and Federal Prisons, 1980–2014
