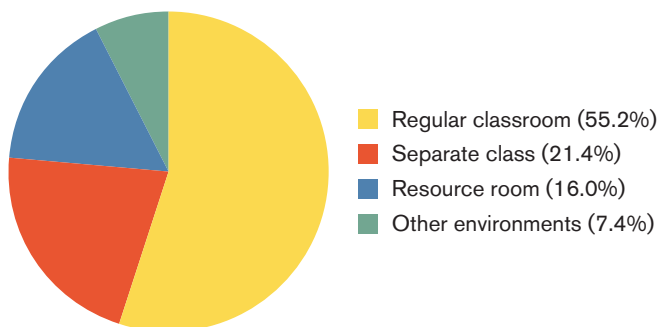
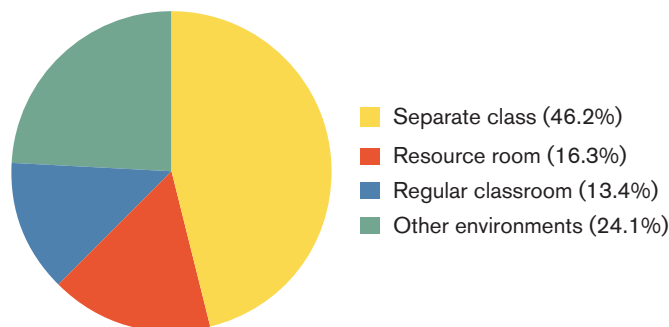


FIGURE 14.5 Educational Placement of School-Age Students With Physical Disabilities, Health Disabilities, or Deaf-Blindness

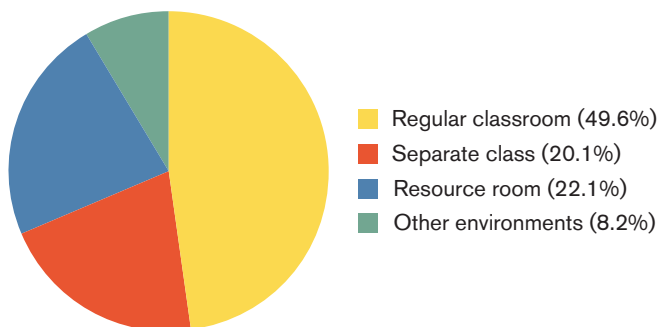
(a) Students with Orthopedic Impairments



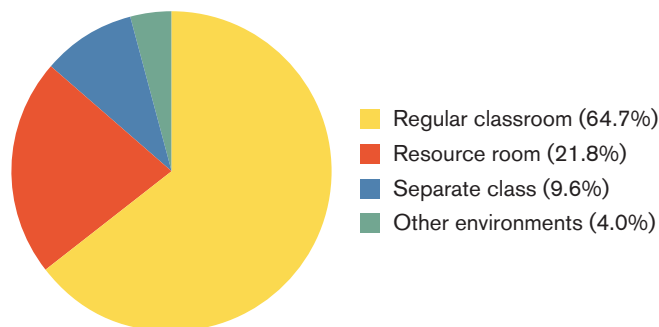
(b) Students with Multiple Disabilities



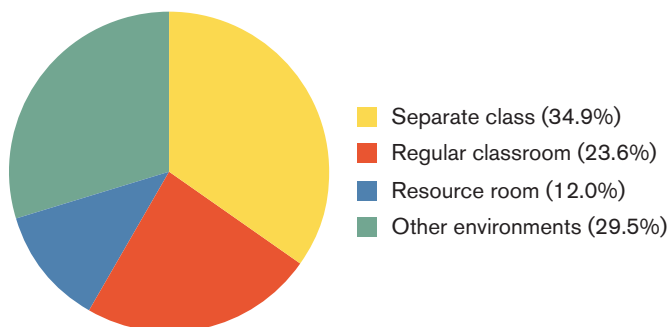
(c) Students with Traumatic Brain Injury
