



## TABLE 13.3 Behavioral Characteristics in Vision Function Problems

Unusual turning of the head, body, or eye

Holding reading material extremely close to the face

Excessive rubbing of the eye

Watery eyes

Eye fatigue

Frequent eye pain

Frequent headaches

Squints or shades the eye to view objects

Constantly having difficulty in keeping up when reading and writing

Using markers such as pencils and fingers when reading

Difficulty copying from the board or transparencies

Confusion in writing letters and numbers appropriately

"Clumsy" movement from one environment to another

Poor posture in both standing and sitting

Reluctance to participate in social and physical activities

Poor grades

Difficulty with color identification or color coordination

Sensory perceptual coordination

Misaligns columns when writing math problems

Requires additional time to complete a task

Fails to make eye contact when talking to people

Behavior problems
