Burglary Versus Robbery

Burglary refers to a property crime in which someone enters a dwelling without permission. Homes, trailers, sheds, apartments, hotel rooms, and offices are examples of dwellings that can be burglarized. Robbery refers to a personal violent crime. Robbery involves an

incident in which someone takes or attempts to take something of value directly from another person.

Remember, a house is burglarized while a person is robbed.
