Dataset	Description
NCVS lone offender assaults 1992 to 2013.sav	This is data from the National Crime Victimization Survey (NCVS), a nationally representative study of individuals' experience of criminal victimization. This particular dataset contains responses from 1992 to 2013, allowing for larger numbers of uncommon offenses to be used in analyses. It also only includes data from respondents who reported either violent or nonviolent assault by a single offender.

Variables for Exercise

Variable Name	Description
Year	The year in which the data were collected, ranges from 1992 to 2013
Maleoff	The sex of the offender, where 1 = <i>male</i> and 0 = <i>female</i>
Injury	A binary variable indicating if the respondent was physically injured during the assault, where 1 = <i>injured</i> and 0 = <i>uninjured</i>
Age_r	The age (in years) at which victimization occurred. This variable is cut off at 75
Victimreported	A binary variable indicating whether the respondent reported their victimization to the police, where 1 = <i>reported</i> and 0 = <i>not reported</i>
Vic18andover	An age binary, where 0 = <i>victimization occurred below 18 years old</i> and 1 = <i>victimization occurred after 18</i>
Relationship	Nominal level variable where 0 = <i>stranger</i> , 1 = <i>slightly known</i> , 2 = <i>casual acquaintance</i> , 3 = <i>well known</i>
