Dataset	Description
GSS 2014.sav	The GSS is a nationally representative survey that is conducted every two years. It covers a wide range of core topics, such as political and religious views, while also rotating in new topics. It is a split-ballot omnibus survey.

Variables for Exercise

Variable Name	Description
Race	A three-category race measure where 1 = <i>white</i> , 2 = <i>black</i> , and 3 = <i>other</i>
Educcat	A four-category ordinal measure of respondent's education where 0 = <i>less than high school</i> , 1 = <i>high school</i> , 2 = <i>some college</i> , 3 = <i>college or more</i>
Polhitok	A yes or no binary question asking respondents if there is any situation in which they would feel it was okay for a police officer to hit a citizen, where 1 = <i>yes</i> and 2 = <i>no</i>
Grass	A binary asking if respondents think marijuana should be made legal or not, where 1 = <i>yes</i> and 2 = <i>no</i>
Raceint	The race of the person who administered the survey, where 1 = <i>white</i> , 2 = <i>black</i> , and 3 = <i>Hispanic</i>
